

## Lake Havasu City Political Signs Notification Form

This form should be used in accordance with the Lake Havasu City Code § 14.04.08 (J) for anyone erecting a political sign. Any person or organization planning to erect political signs relating to a candidate or issue on the ballot of a primary, general, or special election shall file with the City Clerk the name, address, and telephone number of a person who shall be responsible for the proper erection and timely removal of the signs.

1. A si	n shall not be erected any earlier than 71 days prior to an election;				

- 2. A sign shall be removed within 15 days after a general election, except for a candidate in a special election or primary election who does not advance to a general election, the period ends 15 days after the primary or special election;
- 3. Signs shall contain the name and telephone number of the candidate or campaign committee contact person;
- 4. Signs located in an area zoned for residential use shall have a maximum area of 16 square feet;
- 5. Signs located in any other area shall have a maximum area of 32 square feet;
- 6. Signs may be placed within the public right-of-way except in the commercial tourism, commercial resort, and hotel sign free zone designated by the city (See attached Figure 4.08-3);
- 7. Signs shall not be erected on public/city owned property, utility poles, railings, or similar devices, medians, or in a location that is hazardous to public safety, obstructs clear vision in the area, or interferes with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
