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About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Lake Havasu City. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts at Polco's National Research Center.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 1,699 residents of Lake Havasu City collected from March 19, 2021 to May 7, 2021. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 2% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2021 survey was 22%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Lake Havasu City.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Lake Havasu City's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Lake Havasu City residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Lake Havasu City's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Lake Havasu City's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City's 2021 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within Lake Havasu City were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Lake Havasu City was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve Lake Havasu City households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of Lake Havasu City boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 8,000 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on March 19, 2021 and the survey remained open for seven weeks. For 4,000 households, the first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. The final mailing contained a reminder letter, another survey, and a postage-paid return envelope. For the remaining 4,000 households, the first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate, followed one week later by a reminder postcard. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 6% of the 8,000 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 7,552 households that received the invitations to participate, 1699 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 22%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for Lake Havasu City survey is no greater than plus or minus two percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (1,699 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by Lake Havasu City. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with one small update; it included a question at the end asking where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on April 23, 2021. The survey remained open for two weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2017 American Community Survey estimates for adults in Lake Havasu City. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python, and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Highlights

Lake Havasu City is a desirable place to live and residents report a positive sense of community.

About 8 in 10 residents positively rated the overall quality of life in Lake Havasu City and the city as a place to live, while 7 in 10 gave high marks to the overall image or reputation of Lake Havasu City and sense of community. These ratings were all positive and on par with the national benchmarks. Residents' assessments of the city as a place to retire were outstanding and higher than the national average. About 80% of respondents would recommend living in Lake Havasu City to someone who asked and planned to remain in the community for the next five years.

Residents are pleased with their local government.

Respondents' assessment of the overall quality of services provided by Lake Havasu City were positive and on par with comparison communities, with 68% rating this as excellent or good. Residents also positively reviewed the overall customer service provided by Lake Havasu City employees (79%), treating residents with respect (63%), and public information services (62%). All other aspects of government performance were favorably rated by around half of respondents, which is similar to the national averages. Residents were asked to select the statement about City taxes and services that best described their opinion. About 10% of respondents indicated they were willing to pay more City taxes to get more City services, 22% felt they pay too much for the City services they receive, and 68% said they would need more information to provide an accurate opinion of City services and funding.

The economy is an important focus area for the community in the coming years.

Residents' evaluations of Lake Havasu City as a place to visit were exceptional and much higher than the national benchmark, with 94% rating this as excellent or good. Similar to comparison communities, about two-thirds of respondents favorably rated the overall quality of business and service establishments and 6 in 10 assigned positive reviews to the overall economic health of the city and the vibrancy of the downtown/commercial area. However, respondents' assessments of the city as a place to work, employment opportunities, and shopping opportunities were lower than average; possibly highlighting an area for improvement. When residents were asked to rate how important it was for the community to focus on various matters in the coming two years, the overall economic health of Lake Havasu City was given the highest importance, with 94% rating this as essential or very important.

Community design may be an opportunity for improvement.

Less than half of respondents (45%) gave excellent or good ratings to the overall design or layout of Lake Havasu City's residential and commercial areas, which was lower than the national benchmark. Other areas where residents' ratings were lower than the national average included well-designed neighborhoods, variety of housing options, well-planned commercial growth, availability of affordable quality housing, and code enforcement. When residents were asked to select the statement that came closest to their opinion about code enforcement, 39% indicated that code enforcement should be reactive and the City should only enforce code violations when a complaint is made, even if it means it takes longer to issue notices for and resolve violations. About 61% indicated that code enforcement should be proactive and the City should actively look for and enforce code violations, even if it means the City has to spend more funding to hire staff. Additionally, about two-thirds of respondents felt that a second bridge should be built spanning the Bridgewater Channel connecting the mainland and the island.

Residents applaud the natural environment.

About 85% of residents gave high marks to the overall quality of the natural environment in Lake Havasu City. At least 6 in 10 positively reviewed recycling, yard waste pick-up, Lake Havasu City open space, preservation of natural areas, and cleanliness of the community. These ratings were all positive and on par with comparison communities. Respondents' assessments of air quality and water resources (beaches, lakes, ponds, riverways, etc.) were exceptional and higher than the national benchmarks.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation. The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).

Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.

Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 58% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 58% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 82% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 82%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (up-down) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (right-left). Services categorized as higher in importance and lower in quality may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary.

















Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), Lake Havasu City conducted a survey of 8,000 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from March 19, 2021 to May 7, 2021. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by Lake Havasu City. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with one small update; it included a question at the end asking where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on April 23, 2021. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 291 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2017 American Community Survey estimates for adults in Lake Havasu City. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.
