Mandatory Trash Fee

Every residence that does not have a trash bin is charged monthly by the City for trash service. This is a mandatory charge that can only be terminated upon the termination of all water service to the premises.

Water

Establishment/Reconnect Fee

Each applicant for water service must sign an application. Every applicant shall be liable for services furnished until the city receives written notice to cancel and shut off the water.

It shall be the duty of every applicant to notify the city of any change in ownership or occupancy of said premises at least two days prior to such change.

There is no charge to permanently discontinue service at the applicant's request. Service that is temporarily discontinued, at the applicant's request, will be charged a reconnect fee upon reconnecting.

Deposit Fee

Applicants for water service may be required to pay a deposit fee based upon the type of service requested. The deposit will be held for one year. If the customer has a satisfactory payment record, the deposit will be applied as payment to their account. Deposits will not be applied to delinquent accounts unless service is cancelled.

Regulations

Meters are read monthly and billings are mailed monthly. You will be charged for all water received through your meter during the period between the two meter reading dates plus a monthly meter charge. These charges are due and payable immediately.

If charges are not paid by the 20th day after the date of billing, they are delinquent and a penalty of 10% of the total bill shall be added. For each successive 20-day period that the bill remains unpaid, an additional 10% of the amount of the total bill shall be added.

Failure to receive bills or notices shall not prevent such bills from becoming delinquent, nor relieve the customer of his obligations. When a bill becomes delinquent by 5 days, which shall be 25 days after billing, the city will notify the user of the delinquency which will result in discontinuance of service if not paid within 10 days. Users will have the opportunity for a hearing before the discontinuance of service by contacting Customer Service. The city may, without any further notice, discontinue service until all outstanding charges are paid in full, including a charge for restoration of service.

A water user having a delinquent account on one premise may not receive water services on a new or other account on another premise until the delinquent account has been paid, including penalties, if any.
