Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) Collections Report

January 2023



This month's TPT Collection Report includes all collections through January (merchant collections through December 2022). Arizona Department of Revenue provides tax collection information.

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) TPT collection is 2.8% or \$507,948 above estimate and 3.1% above the prior year for the same reporting period. The month-over-month is a -2.7% or (\$92,792) decrease.



January year-over-year TPT collection increased in Restaurants and Use Tax. There was a decrease in Accommodations, Rentals, Retail, and Construction. The restaurant increased \$27,207 or 5.4%, Use Tax increased \$41,429 or 17.4%.

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




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


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
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Retail Sales



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Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually, and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
