Lake Havasu City Awarded Landscaping Beautification Grant

Lake Havasu City is pleased that the community has been selected to receive Transportation Enhancement program grant funding through the Arizona Department of Transportation. These funds are for both the city-owned planter strip on State Route 95 near Palo Verde North, as well as the Kingman District's application for a State project for the Lake Havasu Landscaping Project, Phase III (Mulberry South). The City project will landscape the parcels adjacent to SR 95 and provide infrastructure to future landscaping on the highway right-of-way. The State project will landscape those areas of SR 95 south of Mulberry Avenue that are fronted by residential and state properties. ADOT is also currently working on the design of the Phase II project, which runs from Mesquite Avenue to Palo Verde South on SR 95.

The Transportation Enhancement (TE) program was developed to enhance surface transportation activities by developing projects that go above and beyond what transportation departments can typically do. These projects are valued at approximately \$400,000 to \$500,000 each and will require a match of approximately 5% from the City for its project.

"Lake Havasu City would like to thank the Kingman District for their efforts on these applications, said interim public works director Mark Clark. "I would also like to thank Mr. Jeff LeMire, City Project Manager, for his effort on behalf of the citizens of Lake Havasu City."
