Lake Havasu City Resident Wanted for Aggravated Assault

Lake Havasu City Police detectives were called to assist patrol officers investigate an aggravated assault that occurred in the 2100 block of McCulloch Boulevard North at approximately 2:00 a.m. on February 1, 2010.

Investigation revealed that a 24-year-old victim was stabbed several times in the upper torso during an argument. The victim stumbled to the area of McCulloch Blvd. North and Querio Drive where patrol officers spotted him and rendered assistance. The victim was bleeding from multiple stab wounds and was transported to Havasu Regional Medical Center and later transferred by helicopter to a Las Vegas area hospital.

Detectives learned the stabbing was the culmination of an argument in an area establishment between the victim and Ramey Villanueva. Villanueva is a 23-year-old Lake Havasu City resident that was paroled from Arizona state prison within the last two weeks. He is described as a Hispanic male, approximately 5 feet 10 inches tall, weighing approximately 160 pounds. Villanueva has a tattoo of the state of Texas on the right side of his neck as well as the word “Texas” on his left hand.

Villanueva, also a parole absconder wanted by state parole officers, is considered armed and dangerous with violent tendencies.

The police department is asking anyone with information about Villanueva’s whereabouts to call 911 immediately.
