**Police Seeking Public's Assistance with Numerous Recreational Vehicle Break-Ins**

The Lake Havasu City Police Department is seeking the public's assistance with the identification of suspect(s) responsible for numerous break-ins of recreational vehicles parked in a storage yard in the 900 block of Beachcomber Boulevard.

The break-ins occurred between the evening of October 26<sup>th</sup> and the morning of October 27<sup>th</sup>. Several thousands of dollars in damage was done to the motor homes and travel trailers when the suspect(s) broke windows to gain access to the interiors of the vehicles. Other vehicles had their doors and storage bins ruthlessly pried open, causing additional damage.

Property belonging to some of the victims was found in the immediate area. Crime scene investigators were called to the scene to process the recreational vehicles for evidence and the case is actively being investigated by police detectives.

Residents are encouraged to call the police department with any information they feel may help solve this crime. They can speak to a detective or make an anonymous tip by calling Havasu Silent Witness at 928-854-TIPS (8477). Cash rewards are available if a tip results in the arrest and prosecution of the suspect of a crime.
