Search Warrant Nets Heroin and Cash

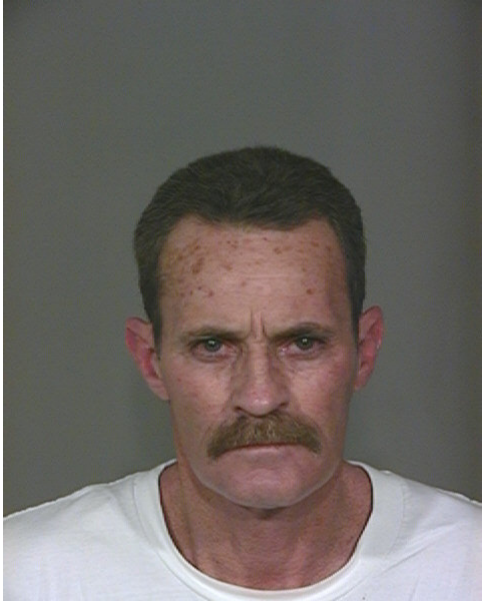
On February 4, 2012, at approximately 1:30 p.m. Lake Havasu City police arrested 54-year-old Lake Havasu City resident Orville Larrance at the intersection of State Route 95 and Lake Drive after he was stopped for driving on a suspended driver's license. Larrance was found to be in possession of approximately 7.4 grams of heroin at the time of his arrest.

A search warrant was served at Larrance's residence in the 3000 block of Joyce Lane (Desert Hills) following his arrest. The search of the residence by Special Investigations Bureau detectives resulted in the seizure of an additional 102 grams of heroin, 2 grams of methamphetamine, 1 ounce of marijuana, and approximately 50 prescription-only narcotic pills. Detectives also seized scales, packaging materials, \$3,700 in cash and other items that are commonly used to facilitate drug sales. Other items worth approximately \$10,000 were seized from the home that are believed to be the proceeds of drug sales. It is believed that Larrance was a significant source of heroin in Lake Havasu City and the surrounding area.

The street value of the heroin is approximately \$21,800, methamphetamine approximately \$200, marijuana approximately \$200, and the prescription-only narcotic pills is approximately \$500.

Larrance was charged with possession of narcotic drugs for sale, two counts of possession of narcotic drugs, possession of dangerous drugs, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of marijuana. All charges are felonies. After his initial appearance, Larrance was held on a \$30,000 cash-only bond and transferred to the custody of the Mohave County Sheriff's Office.
