Two Arrested for Burglary, Additional Suspect Sought

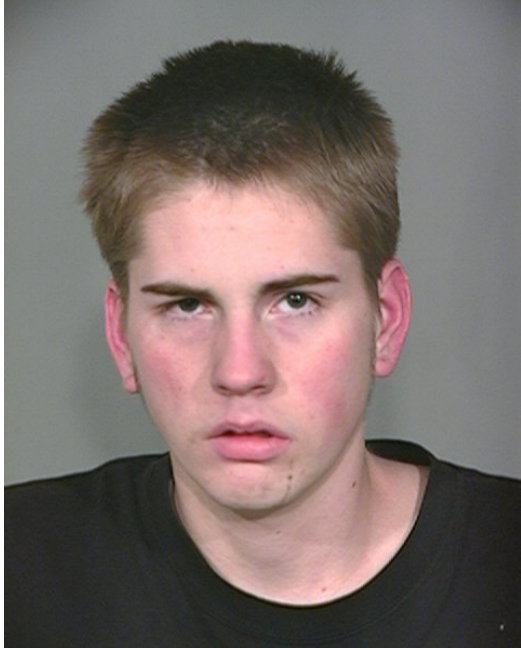
On January 19, 2012, at approximately 3:15 a.m., an officer made a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 2100 block of Moyo Drive. The car was being driven by 18-year-old Lake Havasu City resident Dylan Helbert. 18-year-old Lake Havasu City resident Daniel Knight was the passenger. Helbert provided a false name to officers on-scene; however, officers discovered his true identity and arrested him for an outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrant. Officers were able to determine the vehicle they stopped was an unreported stolen vehicle from a residence in the 2000 block of Papago Lane that was burglarized earlier in the night. Helbert was additionally charged with second degree burglary and theft of means of transportation. Knight was arrested and also charged with second-degree burglary and theft of means of transportation. All charges are felonies.

Helbert and Knight had their initial court appearance on January 19, 2012. Both received a \$10,000 bond and were transferred to the custody of the Mohave County Sheriff's Office.

The investigation implicated 20-year-old Lake Havasu City resident David Merritt in the residential burglary and theft of the vehicle. Merritt has not been located. Anyone having information about Merritt's whereabouts is asked to call the Lake Havasu City Police Department at 928-855-1171. Merritt's photo is attached. Anonymous information can be called into Lake Havasu Silent Witness at 928-854-TIPS (8477). Cash rewards are available if information results in the capture of a wanted fugitive, or the arrest and prosecution of the suspect of a crime.
