**Lake Havasu City Public Works Department**  
**August 30, 2010**

As of July 1, 2010, rebates for water conservation efforts are available from a Bureau of Reclamation grant. Sixty thousand dollars is currently available to help pay for the purchase cost of low water volume toilet conversions, swimming pool covers, and hot water recirculation pumps. **SEWER CONSTRUCTION**

Cisco Area Sewers: Milling will take place on Horizon Drive (from Desert Rose to the end).  
Paving will take place on Treasure Drive (from Arabian Drive to Caravan Drive), Arabian Court (from Arabian Drive to the end), Arabian Circle (from Arabian Drive to the end), Arabian Drive (from Simitan Drive to Arabian Court), and Arabian Drive (from Arabian Court to Desert View Drive).

Tarpon II Area Sewers: No milling or paving has been scheduled this week.

Tarpon Downstream: Paving will take place on Jones Drive (from Snead Drive to Green Drive) and Green Drive (from Jones Drive to Acoma Blvd).

Mockingbird Area Sewers: Milling will take place on Hassayampa Drive (from Hassayampa Way to Bluebird Drive).

Chemehuevi Area Sewers: Milling will take place on Star Drive (from Thunderbolt Avenue to Oconowoc Drive) and Saratoga Court (from Saratoga Avenue).

Trotwood Area Sewers: Milling will take place on Alley 44 (from Arapaho Drive to Oro Grande Blvd.).

**WATER DIVISION**

Crews will be repairing service line leaks at the following locations:  
Chandler Drive                      Sea Knight Drive  
Duel Drive                              Hughes Lane  
Demaret Drive                        Avalon Drive

Crews will be upgrading the existing service lines on Deepwater Drive.

Distribution crews will be assisting the sewer contractors with shut downs for water service line replacements. Crews will also be working on the replacement of commercial water meters, as well as performing upgrades to existing water service lines. Distribution crews will be exercising main line valves ahead of the sewer contractors.

Production crews will be testing the SCADA System radios located at the Booster Stations. Crews will also be installing roof railing on top of the reservoir at Station 2A. Production crews will be installing the rebuilt electric motor at Well 13. Crews will be upgrading the electrical system located at the Water Treatment Plant aeration and further testing of the Pump 11 motor and pump.

**WASTEWATER**

Collection cleaning crews will be cleaning various sections of the collection throughout the week.

Lift station maintenance crew will be doing rounds and preventive maintenance for our 70 plus lift stations.

Video inspection crews will be televising new sewer laterals and main lines.

Swanson Avenue @ Acoma Blvd.

Sign crews will be preparing and setting up traffic control measures for the upcoming Labor Day holiday weekend. Repairs and upgrades will be performed as needed throughout the week. Crews will continue monitoring barricades that have been left at several project sites.
