PURPOSE:

Award bid for the Tank N-2A-07 Replacement Project (Project No. 108023) in accordance with City Code Section 3.10.040.

BACKGROUND:

On May 5, 2021, sealed bids were opened for the project and five (5) bids were received in response. The five responsive bidders were:

Paso Robles Tank, Inc.	\$2,299,285.00
Technology Construction, Inc.	\$2,441,750.00
KEAR Civil Corp.	\$2,529,450.00
Haydon Companies, LLC	\$2,641,027.00
Walker River Construction, Inc.	\$2,973,973.00

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

The replacement of existing Tank N-2A-07, an existing 1.0 Million Gallon (MG) aged tank, with a new 1.5 MG tank will allow for continued service and increased storage capacity as the City's population continues to grow.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Sufficient budget is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Capital Improvement Plan for Tank N-2A-07 Replacement Project in the amount of \$2,500,000.
