Award Bid for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Fog Seal Program to Cholla Pavement Maintenance Inc. *(Ken Porosky)*

**FUNDING SOURCE:**

Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF) 121-3510-5220 (Street Repair Contractual Svcs)

**PURPOSE:**

Award bid for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Fog Seal Program in accordance with City Code Sections §§ 3.10.010 and 3.10.030.

**BACKGROUND:**

Lake Havasu City maintains its roadways with standard maintenance practices, including the fog sealing of those paved roadways in good condition.

Approximately 414,776 square yards of roadway will be treated at \$0.58 per square yard, which is equivalent to approximately 22 miles of roadways or 5% of City streets. Last year approximately 999,245 square yards were sealed at \$0.46 per square yard. There were four (4) bids submitted for this work from Cholla Pavement Maintenance Inc. of \$240,030.40 to a high of \$488,429.24. The average of all four (4) bids was \$322,431.51.

**COMMUNITY IMPACT:**

By contracting this work out, the City maximizes the efficiency and effectiveness of our community's resources allocated to roadway maintenance. Fog sealing roadways seals the surface and prevents the loss of fine aggregate in asphaltic concrete pavements. This extends the life of the pavement and maintains a smoother surface.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Sufficient funds of \$240,030.40 are available in the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Highway User Revenue Fund (Street Repair Contractual Services) to perform the work.
