Award Bid for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Crack Seal Program to Holbrook Asphalt Company (*Ken Porosky*)

FUNDING SOURCE:

Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF) 121-3510-52220

PURPOSE:

Award bid for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Crack Seal Program, Project SM313N-B21-500204 in accordance with City Code §§ 3.10.010 and 3.10.030.

BACKGROUND:

Lake Havasu City maintains its roadways with standard maintenance practices, including the crack sealing of those roadways scheduled for future chip seal or asphalt concrete pavement in need of this treatment. Cracks form in pavement due to its expanding and contracting caused by hot and cold temperatures. Crack sealing prevents water infiltration improving the lifespan of the pavement.

The City provides the crack seal material to the contractor from the Arizona State Contract pricing, ensuring a low cost for materials. This year's program cost for labor is approximately \$0.21 per square yard. This is an increase from last year's price of \$0.18 per square yard.

Approximately 1,287,122 square yards will be treated this year, this is the equivalent of approximately 180 lane miles of roadways and 8% of our parking/walking paths, or about 14.5% of our total assets.

There were six bids submitted for this work, ranging from the low bid from Holbrook Asphalt Co. of \$269,890 to a high of \$950,000. The average of all five bids was \$473,295.

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

By contracting out this work, the City maximizes the efficiency and effectiveness of the community's resources. Crack sealing extends the life of the roadways and maximizes the community's return on investment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funds are available in the Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF) for Fiscal Year 2021-22.
