

## ADDENDUM NO. 1

North Well Field Pump and Downhole Improvement Project Project 108032

**DATED: JUNE 21, 2023** 

This addendum no. 1 forms a part of the contract described above.

## Item No. 1:

The following questions were received from bidders. Answers are provided herein by the OWNER:

1. Question: "When is the work expected to begin?"

**Answer:** It is anticipated the work will begin mid to end of October.

2. Question: "Are the allotted 90 Calendar Days per each well?"

Answer: No. It is for the two base bid wells, wells 10 & 14.

3. **Question:** "Does the 90 Calendar Days also include the work on the alternate well 15?"

**Answer:** No. If bids come in such that there is available budget to do well 15, additional 45 calendar days will be added for that work.

4. Question: "Can regular carbon Steel be used as the swedging material?"

Answer: Yes.

5. Question: "Do you have video of the hole if well 15 casing?"

**Answer:** Yes, and it shows it to be approximately 4" in diameter.

6. Question: "Will the City perform the Bac-T tests?"

Answer: Yes.

7. **Question:** "Are you going to spec out chlorination quantity required?"

**Answer:** No. It is to be standard AWWA requirements.

8. **Question:** "When it comes to discharging the wells will we have to provide the piping and where would we be able to pipe it to?"

**Answer:** No. You will be able to use existing underground piping to flush to the wash north of the wells. De-Chlorination will be required.

9. Question: "Will the City accept a sterling product on the well pump?"

**Answer:** Yes, if it is equal to the product being specified.

10. Question: "Do we need to bail into a tank?"

Answer: Yes.

11. Question: "Will the City provide a place to dump the solids?"

**Answer:** No. You will need to contain and haul off.

12. Question: "When refurbishing the heads will we need to include a nipple?"

**Answer:** No as they should be good.

13. Question: "Can weekly meetings be held via Teams?"

Answer: Yes.

14. Question: "Can the bids be mailed in as long as they get there before the deadline?"

Answer: Yes.

15. Question: "Are there working daytime limits?"

**Answer:** Yes. City code (9.30.070 B2) allows work on Construction Projects from 5:00 am to 10:00 pm from May 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> and 6:00 am to 10:00 pm October 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>.

16. Question: "Do we need to dispose of materials/equipment removed?"

**Answer:** Yes. City would like to salvage equipment that is still operable and of value. This can be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

17. **Question:** "Will the electrical panels that appear to be in the way be relocated prior to construction by the City?"

Answer: No.

18. Question: "Does the engine at Well 15 stay?"

Answer: Yes.

19. Question: "What is the KVA of the power lines running by the wells?"

**Answer:** City was unable to verify with Unisource. Contractor will need to do so.
