Attention is called to the following changes, additions, clarifications and/or deletions to the original solicitation and they shall be considered in preparing submissions:

There is no change in the opening time. **Submissions are due no later than 3:00 p.m., Arizona Time, November 12, 2025**, at the City Clerk's Office, 2330 McCulloch Blvd. N., Lake Havasu City, AZ 86403 or electronically via the City's DemandStar Network at <https://www.demandstar.com/app/buyers/bids/510321/details>.

If your bid is already in transit, the City Clerk's Office will hold it for opening on the New [Bid] Opening Date unless we are notified otherwise. If your [bid] has already been electronically submitted via DemandStar, you do have access to make changes prior to the time of the opening. [Bidder] may then email a Receipt Confirmation to Purchasing@lhcaz.gov which will be placed with your bid package.

ITEM	ACTION	DESCRIPTION or ISSUE
1	Clarification	Please review the following questions and answers for further clarification

Question: *Does the City want temporary fencing if gates are to be deducted from the bid?*

Answer: No, temporary fencing will not be required. The City will provide and install the gates immediately after the Contractor completes their portion of the fencing for each field.

Question: *Will the 12' fencing remain on Field 4?*

Answer: Yes. The 12' existing fence on Field 4 is to remain intact.

Question: *Regarding the electricity that is attached to the fencing poles, are we to replace the electric?*

Answer: Any electrical components connected to the fencing will be handled by Parks & Recreation staff.

Question: *Will Contractors be able to work on multiple fields at once?*

Answer: No, the City's intent is to close only one field at a time. The Contractor must fully complete work on each field before beginning work on the next.

Question: *Will Contractors be installing Foul Ball Posts?*

Answer: City staff will install Foul Ball Posts.

Question: *Does the City require yellow top cap on fence?*

Answer: No, yellow top cap is not required on the 8' or 10' fences.

Question: *Do Contractors have to cover holes?*

Answer: Yes, with cones for safety reasons.

Question: *Are Contractors to replace slats/screening, especially on the back of the dug outs?*

Answer: Work will be performed from dugout to dugout. Contractors are not required to replace/install slats or screening on any part of the fence.

Question: Will there be water available at the site?

Answer: Yes

Question: Please clarify the foul ball range section of fencing to be left out (72' and 75')

Answer: These sections are to remain.

Question: On which field will Contractors start?

Answer: TBD on award of Contract
