Award Bid for Fiscal Year 2019-20 Fog Seal Program to Cholla Pavement Maintenance, Inc. (*Kenneth Porosky*)

FUNDING SOURCE:

HURF (Highway User Revenue Fund)

PURPOSE:

Award bid for Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20 Fog Seal Program in accordance with City Code § 3.10.030.1.5, Formal Purchases. (Project No. SM312C)

BACKGROUND:

Lake Havasu City maintains its roadways with standard maintenance practices, including the fog sealing of those paved roadways in good condition or previously slurry sealed.

Approximately 645,000 square yards of roadway will be treated at \$0.45 per square yard down from last year's awarded bid at \$0.55 per square yard, this is equivalent to approximately 41 miles (7.5%) of roadways. Only one bid was received. FY 2018-19 fog seal program amounted to 140,000 square yards treated equivalent to 6.4 miles of roadway.

It is the Department's recommendation to move forward with award of this bid, not anticipating any savings in a rebid. The contractors who usually bid our work indicated that they are busy with other contracts in the metropolitan areas.

The quantity of fog sealing this year is increased significantly as the City is addressing areas of Sewer Program pavement that can continue to be maintained by the application of a fog seal rather than requiring a chip seal.

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

By contracting this work out, the City can maximize the efficiency and effectiveness of our community's resources allocated to roadway maintenance. Fog sealing roadways seals the surface and prevents the loss of fine aggregate in asphaltic concrete pavements and slurry seals. This extends the life of the pavement and maintains a smoother surface.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Sufficient funds are available in the FY 2019-20 Highway User Revenue Fund (Street Repair Contractual Services) to perform the work.
