PURPOSE:

Award bid for Construction Contract 500396 to Pioneer Earthmovers, Inc., for the Palo Verde Boulevard South, Industrial Boulevard & Kiowa Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation (Project No. B24-PW-500396-10818) in accordance with City Code §§ 3.10.010.2 (A.R.S. Title 34) and 3.10.030.1.

BACKGROUND:

This project was highly rated in the recent Pavement Priority Rating. Council has taken recent action to allocate funding to the Streets Division for more paving projects of our streets. This project will be the result of a portion of that allocation. Our Engineering Division has utilized Trico Engineering Incorporated for the preparation of plans and specifications for this project.

On August 9, 2023, sealed bids were opened and publicly read for the project and two (2) bids were received in response.

The responsive low bidder is as follows:

Pioneer Earthmovers, Inc. Base Bid \$1,462,816

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

This project will provide enhanced street surfacing utilizing Council dedicated funding to an important Industrial/Commercial corridor in the City.
