Award Bid for the North Well Field Pump and Downhole Improvement Project to Weber Water Resources, LLC

FUNDING SOURCE:

Water Utility Fund

PURPOSE:

Award construction contract 500383 for the North Well Field Pump and Downhole Improvement Project in accordance with City Code Section 3.10.040.

BACKGROUND:

In 2007, the City completed a Comprehensive Water Master Plan, with an update completed in 2018. A critical element of the 2018 Water Master Plan was to address water supply capacity, reliability and vulnerability and provide recommendations to ensure long-term sustainability of the City's water source and the Horizontal Collector Well.

Since placing the Horizontal Collector Well (HCW) into service in 2004, it has not been shut-down to allow for much needed maintenance. With the completion of the two new wells, wells 22 & 23, it is now time to move forward with the next phase of the project rehabilitation of four wells in the north well field. This addendum will allow for additional focus not captured in the original contract as well as assistance during the bidding and construction phase to ensure that project is bid and constructed according to the plans.

On June 28, 2023, sealed bids were opened for the project and two (2) bids were received in response. The two responsive bidders were:

Weber Water Resources, LLC -

- Base Bid + Force Account + Additive Alternate Bid = \$386,307.00

KP Ventures Well Drilling & Pump Co., LLC -

- Base Bid + Force Account + Additive Alternate Bid = \$537,690.54

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

This construction of this improvement project to the North Wellfield Wells 10, 14 & 15 will maintain reliability and operability of the water system for City residents.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funds in the amount of \$386,307 are available in the Capital Improvement Plan from the Water Utility Fund.
