2020-21 After School Program  
Parent Information

Dear Parents,

It is important that all parents read and understand the changes to our upcoming 2020-21 After School Program. The changes and procedures that we have put into place follow CDC & the LHUSD guidelines for the safety of all our participants, staff, and families.

We are asking parents to please discuss with your participant the importance of hand washing, social distancing and other safety practices advised by the CDC. If at any time your participant shows any symptoms or falls into the CDC criteria of risk ([cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov)), please keep them home and consult your medical provider or health department.

- LHC Parks & Recreation After School Program will be offered to participants K through 6th grade, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday (2:30-6pm) and Wednesday (1:00-6pm) beginning Tuesday, September 8th. The cost for the program will be \$116 per participant /\$72 each additional participant in same family. Registration can be completed online only beginning Monday, August 31st.
- Instructions for the online process are available on the website.
- The After School program will be offered at all 6 LHUSD elementary sites with a limited number of participants at each site. (First come first serve)
- All staff and participants will be required to wear face coverings at all times with the exception for times when participants can maintain proper physical distancing (6ft), are outside, or until the AZ Department of Health Services determines face coverings are no longer necessary.
- Check out will be done at the exterior of each site gym by the on-site leaders and staff. Parents/Guardians will not be allowed into the building. Upon arrival parents will ring the exterior doorbell and a staff will exit for participant name, check i.d. and have them called for pick-up.
- If a participant or staff displays a temperature during the day of 100.4 they will be immediately removed from the program and placed into isolation until picked up. You or anyone on pick-up list must be available at any time to pick up your participant.
- Participants will be assigned to a squad based on grade. Squad ratios will be 1 leader to 10-15 participants.
- Participants will have multiple fun activities, art and some equipment for use throughout the program and will have P.E. time in the gym with their squad. At this time participants will not be taking any field trips.
- Site will be routinely cleaned, sanitized and disinfected during the program per the CDC recommendations.
