Prevention Fee Schedule

The Fire Marshal shall not authorize an inspection or re-inspection until the permittee has paid all fee(s). Fees are charged per inspection.

For your convenience, permit fees can be paid by cash, check (payable to *Lake Havasu City*), American Express, Discover, Master Card, or VISA. Online payments can be made if you have an invoice or permit number. The online portal can be reached at Maintstar Permit Public 25.1.20.3838.

Administrative Fees or Penalties

Permit Fees will double when work commences without first obtaining an approved permit fee(s) and having plans approved.

Additional Plan Review -[S-581] - per hour

➤ Design review for redline comments that are re-submitted without correction or re-submittals that may be considered excessive. (Fee per hour)

Fire Safety Reinspection [S-578]

\$173

Reinspection of a commercial or public facility or place of assembly and/or reinspections due to violation correction not ready and/or violation/noncompliance of the appropriate fire code requirements. (Fee per inspection)

Violation A Civil Infraction [City Code 1.12.040]

\$200-\$2,500

- ➤ When the Code Official determines that a violation occurred or is occurring and is unable to secure voluntary correction pursuant to § 1.12.030, the applicable Code Official may issue a notice of civil violation to the person responsible for the violation.
- Penalty. The penalty for each separate violation per day or portion thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$2,500.

CO2 Tank Installation, Removal, or Repair [S-562]

Fireworks Permit [S-569]

- ➤ Process/review a permit application for the manufacture, storage, handling, sale, or use of any quantity of explosives, explosive material, fireworks, or pyrotechnic special effects within the scope of the International Fire Code.

- Minor Modification (Replacement of less than 5 devices due to upgrade or alteration) \$125
- Repair/removal tracking (Tracking purpose only: replacement of power supply; work not qualified as a major alteration, repair of less than 5 devices such as smoke, heat, pull stations, etc.)

Engineered Extinguishing System for Fire Protection
