The Fire Marshal shall not authorize an inspection or re-inspection until the permittee has paid all fee(s). Fees are charged per inspection.

For your convenience, permit fees can be paid by cash, check (payable to Lake Havasu City), American Express, Discover, Master Card, or VISA.

# Permit Fees will double when work commences without first obtaining an approved permit fee(s) and having plans approved.

### Additional Plan Review - [S-033] - per hour

Design review for redline comments that are re-submitted without correction or re-submittals that may be considered excessive. (Fee per hour) (See fee schedule in Uniform Building Code)

### Alarm Responses - False/Miscellaneous Calls [S-551] (billed to property/business owner)

Respond to fire and false alarms and faulty fire systems.

### Fire Safety Reinspection [S-578]

\$249

Assessed when necessary for LHCFD to perform a second or subsequent inspection of a commercial, public facility, or place of assembly to ensure compliance with code requirements, as required by Section 104.2 of the International Fire Code 2018 Edition.

### Fire Permit Reinspection [S-034]

\$147

Reinspection due to a project not ready and/or violation/non-compliance of the appropriate fire code requirements. (Fee per Inspection) (See fee schedule in Uniform Building Code)

#### Violation A Civil Infraction - Penalty [City Code 1.12.040]

\$200 - \$2,500

- 1. When the Code Official determines that a violation occurred or is occurring and is unable to secure voluntary correction pursuant to § 1.12.030, the applicable Code Official may issue a notice of civil violation to the person responsible for the violation.
- 2. Penalty. The penalty for each separate violation per day or portion thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$2,500.
