The Lake Havasu City Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report examines taxes collected during the month of December 2021 by businesses and vendors, which were reported and remitted to the Arizona Department of Revenue in January 2022. Tax collection information is provided by Arizona Department of Revenue.

Sales Tax

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) January 2022 sales tax collections are 32.1% above budget and 10.9% above prior year. The month of January is 14.5% above prior year.





Retail Sales

January retail sales tax collections have Increased by \$191,924 or 9.9% compared to the same period last year. Fiscal Year to Date collections are 9% higher than last year. The largest growth is in Building Materials and Lawn and Garden.



Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
