Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) Collections Report

This month's TPT Collection Report includes all collections through January (merchant collections through December 2023). Arizona Department of Revenue provides tax collection information.

Fiscal Year-to-Date (FYTD) TPT collection is 8.5% or \$1,513,300 above estimate and 2.9% above the prior year for the same reporting period.



January year-over-year TPT collections increased overall, with the highest impact in retail, restaurant & bar, and construction. Retail increased by \$138,991 or 6.9%. Restaurant & bar increased \$56,105 or 12.8%, while construction increased \$39,933 or 11.5%. USE tax decreased by \$67,210 or -28.4%.

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




The high growth in FY21 is due to the influx of visitors from neighboring states with stricter COVID restrictions.

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




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




August 2022 (FY23) includes a \$273,900 taxpayer refund from prior years.

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Retail Sales

Retail sales are the most significant component of the City's overall TPT collections. In January, retail sales tax collections increased by \$138,991, or 6.9% from the previous year. Year-to-date retail sales are flat at 0.7%.



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Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar



Lake Havasu City collects a tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually, and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
