# Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report

The Lake Havasu City Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report examines taxes collected during the month of May 2020 by businesses and vendors, which were reported and remitted to the Arizona Department of Revenue in June 2020. Tax collection information is provided by Arizona Department of Revenue.

### **Sales Tax**

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) June 2020 sales tax collections are 7.1% above budget and 8.5% above prior year. The month of June is 29.3% above prior year.



# **Retail Sales**

June retail sales tax collections have Increased by \$537,489 or 44.0% compared to the same period last year. Fiscal Year to Date collections are 15.1% higher than last year.



# **Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar**

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes are disbursed to the Partnership for Economic Development (PED) (25%) and Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) (75%).
