The Lake Havasu City Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report examines taxes collected during the month of May 2021 by businesses and vendors, which were reported and remitted to the Arizona Department of Revenue in June 2021. Tax collection information is provided by Arizona Department of Revenue.

Sales Tax

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) June 2021 sales tax collections are 55.7% above budget and 78.6% above prior year. The month of June is 20.7% above prior year.









Retail Sales

June retail sales tax collections have Increased by \$97,761 or 5.6% compared to the same period last year. Fiscal Year to Date collections are 26.9% higher than last year. The largest growth is in home furnishings and building materials.



Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
