#### June 2023



This month's TPT Collection Report includes all collections through June (merchant collections through May 2023). Arizona Department of Revenue provides tax collection information.

Fiscal Year, the TPT collection is 0.3% lower than the budget, amounting to \$122,046 less, and 0.4% lower than the previous year for the same reporting period, which translates to \$150,887 less. However, there is a positive development in June, with a month-over-month increase of 1.2%, equivalent to \$41,214.



June year-over-year TPT collection increased overall, with the highest impact in Restaurant & Bar, Retail, and Communications. Retail increased \$88,142 or 4.7%, Restaurant and Bar increased by 14,568 or 2.6%. The most significant decreases were in Construction & Accommodations. Construction declined by \$25,408 or 6.8%, and Accommodations fell by \$15,698 or 3.6%.

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

Retail sales are the most significant component of the City's overall TPT collections. In June, retail sales tax collections increased by \$88,142 or 4.7% from the previous year.



#### **Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar**

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually, and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
