Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) Collections Report

March 2024



This month's TPT Collection Report includes all collections through March (merchant collections through February 2024). Arizona Department of Revenue provides tax collection information.

Fiscal-Year-to-Date (FYTD) TPT collection is 4.1% or \$1,005,063 above estimate and 5.6% above the prior year for the same reporting period.



March year-over-year TPT collections increased overall, with the highest impact in retail, communications, and construction. Retail increased \$44,258 or 2.5%, communications increased by \$29,017 or 68.3%, while construction increased \$50,282 or 14.5%. Restaurant and Bar tax decreased by \$21,669 or -4.9%.

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




The high growth in FY21 is due to the influx of visitors from neighboring states with stricter COVID restrictions.

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




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

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Retail Sales

Retail sales are the most significant component of the City's overall TPT collections. In March, retail sales tax collections increased by \$44,258, or 2.5% from the previous year. Year-to-date retail sales are flat at 1.0%.



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Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar



Lake Havasu City collects a tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually, and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
