## **Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) Collections Report**

### **March 2025**



This month's TPT Collection Report includes all collections through March (merchant collections through February 2025). Arizona Department of Revenue provides tax collection information.

Fiscal year-to-date (FYTD) TPT collection is 6.2% or \$1,480,269 above budget and 0.2% above the prior year. The TPT collection for the month of March 2025 is 4.3% lower compared to the prior year.



Year-to-date through March, TPT collections have increased by 0.2% or \$53,364 compared to the prior year. For March, collections decreased by 4.3% over the previous year, totaling \$137,261. All business classes were below their performance from the prior year except for Use Tax & rental, Leasing & Lic. Construction decreased by \$82,422, or 34.7%; Accommodations by \$7,469, or 4.4%; Restaurant and Bar by \$14,772, or 3.4%; and Retail by \$ 35,215, or 1.9%.

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




The high growth in FY21 is due to the influx of visitors from neighboring states with stricter COVID restrictions.

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




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




February 2024 (FY24) includes a \$261,160 taxpayer refund from prior years.

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### **Retail Sales**

Retail sales are the most significant component of the City's overall TPT collections. In March, retail sales tax collections decreased by \$35,2159 or 1.9% from the previous year.



# Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar



Lake Havasu City collects a tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually, and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (Go Lake Havasu) receives \$1.6 million annually.
