Sales Tax

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) May 2020 sales tax collections are 4.2% above budget and 6.2% above prior year. The month of May is .5% above prior year.











Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes are disbursed to the Partnership for Economic Development (PED) (25%) and Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) (75%).
