Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report

The Lake Havasu City Sales, Use and Accommodation Tax Report examines taxes collected during the month of October 2020 by businesses and vendors, which were reported and remitted to the Arizona Department of Revenue in November 2020. Tax collection information is provided by Arizona Department of Revenue.

Sales Tax

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) November 2020 sales tax collections are 68.2% above budget and 26.0% above prior year. The month of November is 24.7% above prior year.





Retail Sales

November retail sales tax collections have Increased by \$329,860 or 27.3% compared to the same period last year. Fiscal Year to Date collections are 31.6% higher than last year. Note that the Wayfair case - requiring out-of-state online retailers to remit Arizona TPT taxes went into effect 10-1-2019.



Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes support tourism and economic development. The Partnership of Economic Development (PED) receives \$500,000 annually and the Convention & Visitor's Bureau (CVB) receives 75% of the taxes. Year to Date payments to the CVB is \$1,431,730.
