Tax collection information is provided by Arizona Department of Revenue.

Sales Tax

Fiscal Year to Date (FYTD) January 2020 sales tax collections are 7.7% above budget and 8.4% above prior year. The month of January is 11.8% above prior year.







Accommodations and Restaurant & Bar

Lake Havasu City collects an additional tax on accommodations (3%) and restaurant & bar sales (1%). The revenues generated by these additional taxes are disbursed to the Partnership for Economic Development (PED) (25%) and Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) (75%).

Fiscal Year to Date Payments to the PED and CVB have increased by 9.9%.
