# This month in Military History



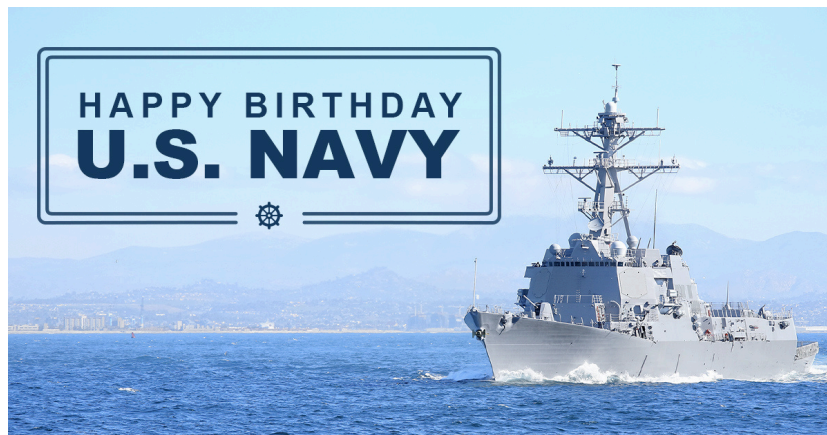
## The U.S. Navy's 250th birthday will be on Monday, October 13, 2025.

On October 13th, 1775, the Continental Navy was established by the Continental Congress during the Revolutionary War to combat the British Royal Navy. Although the Continental Navy was disbanded when the Revolutionary War ended, the Naval Act of 1794 officially called for the reactivation of the country's dormant naval defense and in 1798 the Department of The Navy was created.

Originally commissioned in 1794, the *USS Constitution* (also known as “Old Ironsides”) is the Navy’s oldest active duty vessel. While Old Ironsides does still sail the open sea, her assignment today has her serving as one of the Navy’s most unique historical museums.

Formally established by President John F. Kennedy in 1962, the Navy Seals are “a small, elite maritime military force” used “to conduct Unconventional Warfare. They carry out the types of clandestine, small-unit, high-impact missions that large forces with high-profile platforms (such as ships, tanks, jets and submarines) cannot. SEALs also conduct essential on-the-ground Special Reconnaissance of critical targets for imminent strikes by larger conventional forces.”
