# This Month in Military History



## May 1940 – The “Miracle at Dunkirk”

“We shall not flag or fail...we shall never surrender,” Winston Churchill’s powerful message regarding the evacuation of Allied soldiers from Dunkirk, a small coastal town in France.

On May 10, 1940, Nazi Germany invaded the Netherlands, Luxembourg, and Belgium in multiple blitzkrieg attacks. These attacks were so coordinated and strategic, that the German forces fully occupied these countries within days. Soon after the occupation, the German forces began their assault on France. This assault significantly cut off communication and supply lines between the Allies in the North and South. The hundreds of thousands Allied soldiers in the North were continuously pushed further north by the onslaught of German soldiers into a sliver of coastline in France – Dunkirk.

British Expeditionary Forces commander, General Gort, began the preparing for a possible sea evacuation of all his forces in this constricting area. At first, the British command opposed an evacuation. However, on May 13, Winston Churchill became the new British Prime Minister, and he quickly understood the immensity of the situation in Dunkirk.

Operation Dynamo, the codename for the evacuation operation, began on May 26. On the first day, the British were only able to evacuate 7,500 soldiers. The Luftwaffe, the Nazi air force equivalent, relentlessly bombed the port, preventing the Royal Navy from accessing the levies. Due to this and the shallow beaches of Dunkirk, the Allies put out a call to the public for smaller boats to assist with the evacuation – approximately 1200 boats answered the call. They’re bravery and support allowed for 198,000 British and 140,000 French troops to evacuate the beaches of Dunkirk.

The “Miracle at Dunkirk,” became a rallying cry for the duration of the war. The legacy and impact of Operation Dynamo increased the fervor and pride of the British and Allied forces.
